

## UUC PART# UDPE46 Installation Guide - Underdrive Accessory Pulleys

for E46 330, 328, 325, 323 models

**Professional installation recommended**, but not required. Installer is responsible for determining his or her ability to perform this work competently and safely.

## Parts included:

- (1) replacement power steering pulley (marked as "1")
- (1) replacement water pump pulley (marked as "2")
- (1) replacement accessory belt (part #K060630).


IMPORTANT: BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION, MAKE SURE THE PARTS YOU HAVE MATCH THE LIST ABOVE.

**Tools required:** metric socket set, torx set, flat-blade screwdriver or needle-nose pliers.






**Step 1:** Intake inlet is attached by three push-rivets. Use a flat-blade screwdriver or needle-nose pliers to lift the center portion, and then remove the entire rivet. Retain these pieces for re-use.



Step 2: Remove intake duct by pulling away from part:




**Step 3:** Remove intake parts completely and set aside.




(Note: pre-2001 models with clutch fan will follow standard clutch fan removal procedure and ignore steps 4-7.)

**Step 4:** Fan removal begins by removing this torx bolt located on the right side of vehicle:




Step 5: Unplug electrical connections:








Step 6: Remove push-rivet on left side of car.




Step 7: Lift fan up and out of car.

Step 8: Use a 10mm socket to loosen the four (4) water pump pulley bolts. Do not remove completely.






Step 9: Use a 13mm socket to loosen the three (3) power steering pump pulley bolts marked "B". Do not remove completely.



Step 10: Remove cap from tension roller marked "T" and turn exposed belt to relieve tension on belts:

Step 11: Remove auxiliary belt:




Step 12: Remove main accessory belt marked "A" above.



**Step 13:** Remove original pulleys completely and replace with UUC pulleys. Fasten using original bolts. **IMPORTANT:** accessory pulley bolt torque spec is **16lb-ft.** Do not over-tighten!

**Step 14**: Install new drive belt and auxiliary belt. Note correct routing path:



**Step 15:** Tighten tension roller and replace cap.

**Step 16:** Re-install fan by following steps 4-6 in reverse order.

**Step 17:** Test fitment of accessory belt and auxiliary belt by starting car and listening for squealing. Turn a/c on and listen again. If belts make noise or appear too loose, return to step 15.

Step 18: Re-install intake inlet by following steps 1-3 in reverse order. IMPORTANT: Turn car off before working again!

Step 19: Drive and enjoy!
